



About Grading and Grade Point Average

There are three grading methods for undergraduate courses: a hundred-mark system, a five-letter grading system (A for excellent, B for good, C for moderate, D for passing, F for failing), and a Pass-Fail grading system (P for passing, F for failing). Each method is then converted into grade points, comprehensively measuring the proficiency of the students.

The correspondence between the score and grading points is as follows:

Calculation of Grade Point and Grade Point Average

Conversion Formula:

(1) Course grade points = grade points \times course credits

(2) Grade point average (GPA) = $\frac{\sum \text{Course grade points}}{\sum \text{Course credits}}$
